# 2019 Efasce di Philadelphia Website Committee Report

"A Picture is worth a thousand words" is a popular term. When it comes to web and data "Stuff", I think pictures say it better. So, this year we're providing more charts instead of words. Our WordPress design launched in 2018 shows increased 'users' (aka 'visitors') of 39% compared to this year 2019.



Our Festa dei Friulani drew one of the largest spikes in August and September, and posting our pictures and our Facebook feed kept people coming back in November.

Many more of our Canadezi Fruilan visited this year breaking into the top 10 along with the UK; and we saw

many new countries including Australia, Argentina, and Japan. Dropping from the list was Latvia, Philippines, and Iraq.

So what are people using to view our site? For the browser, Chrome is #1 again, but we saw a notable increase in Mobile phone and a slight drop in tablets (ipads) vs. Desktops:



Educational Programs, Events, and Membership all saw over 7% increases compared to last year. Some of this may be from our members using the website to sign-up and pay for events and membership. We've been sending emails with links and can see they are starting to catch on... Our Festa-dei-friulani and Polenta-dinner events made up close to 8% of our Total traffic and our Language Class makes up almost 6%.

How do people find our site? Mostly from "Direct" sources, meaning a favorite link you saved or typing in "efasce.net" 'directly' in your browser address bar. Search is mostly from Google, Bing, and Yahoo (people still use Yahoo?!); our only Social channel is Facebook (thank you FB users!); and we get referrals from Facebook and Ciaophiladelphia.com.
